Requirements

- Must be 13 years or older (or have an adult with you) at the time of the event to volunteer
- Must stay for entire shift
- Must sign Walk & Wag Participant and Volunteer Waiver through Run Sign Up Site or in person at the Walk & Wag
- Flexibility on your assigned task
- A smiling face!

Packet Pickup:

On the day before the race, assist with checking people into Walk & Wag for One Health 3K & 5K. Assist with selling merchandise, handing out T-shirts, etc.

Race Day Setup Crew:

Assist the LOHA crew in preparing the start/finish areas, Education Zone, Dog Zone, and Kids Zone for participants. Some heavy lifting may be involved.

- -Moving Ice chests, tables, chairs, equipment
- -Setting up banners, table cloths, signs, etc

Race Day Registration and Merch:

You will be handling all things registration and merchandise!

Water Station on Race Route:

You will be stationed along the race route at one of two cooling stations. You will pass out water bottles or cups of water to runners as they pass by, cheer runners on, and clean up any garbage left behind. You will also need to make sure owners have enough water to also give their dogs in their collapsible water bowls.

Education Zone Guide:

You will help keep participants moving through the presentations and hand out quizzes and pens. You will be responsible for picking up quizzes as well. You may also be helping the Education Station presenters with fine tuning set up and clean up. Kid Zone Face Painting:

Paint kids' faces into animals at the Kids Zone. You'll need to show up a little early, and you'll help with cleaning up. Be ready to have an awesome time! Please see your art teacher for details. There will be wipes there for cleanup and choice boards for kids to choose their face painting.

Kid Zone- Inflatable Kids' Activity Timekeeper:

You will referee and keep time to ensure that kids get equal playing time, and all is fair.

Kid Zone- Balloon Animals

This is your chance to show off your balloon animal skills! You will be responsible for making balloon animals for event participants. LOHA will provide balloons

Kids Zone- Pansy Seed Planting:

Help kids plant pansies at the Kids Zone. You'll need to show up a little early, and after the fun, you'll help with cleaning up. Be ready to have an awesome time! Materials will be provided. There will be wipes there for cleanup.

Dog Zone Volunteer

You may be stationed at the adoption area or at one of the dog contests. You will also mingle among participants to make sure pet owners are watching their dogs and keeping them on leashes. Be available to offer water to dog owners if needed, make sure owners have poo bags to pick up their dog's poo if needed. Assist pet owners with whatever they may need while they enjoy their time at the Dog Zone. Help judges in keeping the flow of the "best dog costume" contest and the "best dog trick" contest and assist where needed.

Dog Zone- Smooch Your Pooch Photo Booth

Oversee the Smooch Your Pooch Photo Booth. You will help dogs and their owners get situated in the photo booth, and assist where needed take a pic of participants and their pets using their phone. The photographer will let you know what they need.

Start/Finish Line Cheering Team:

Get runners pumped up for the race and cheer for the runners as the cross the finish line; this shift is great for large groups of people and/or cheerleading teams. Take part in the warm up before the 3k!

What are my transportation/parking options at the event?


There are no pre-arranged parking arrangements or designated lots, so we recommend volunteers arrive early for their volunteer shift to accommodate time to find parking.
